



# MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE.

## 1. I'm registered to vote.

## 2. I plan to vote:

- By absentee ballot
- Early in person
- At the polls on Election Day

## 3. Based on my plan to vote, I know how to:

- Request, complete, and return my absentee ballot
- Find early voting locations in my county
- Find my assigned polling place on Election Day

## 4. I have at least one form of valid ID.

These are the most common:

- Georgia driver's license
- Georgia state ID (also called a Georgia voter ID)
- Government-issued employee photo ID
- U.S. passport
- U.S. military photo ID
- Tribal photo ID
- Student ID from a public college
